The Battle Of Armageddon



(Revelation 14:14-20; 16:12-16; 19:11-21; 20:1-3)

"The Battle of Armageddon" is an expression often used to describe the decisive battle between the Antichrist and his God-hating forces of the earth against Christ.

We are all familiar with the term "global war," by which we mean a war which involves the entire globe. In the past "global" or "World" wars, there were actually nations that remained neutral. These wars may have had world-wide effects, but they were not in actuality "global."

In this last great conflict, however, not one nation will remain neutral as we read how these spirits "go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty." This will indeed be a global war in its fullest sense of the term.

The valley of Megiddo or Jezreel or Esdraelon, is a lovely valley the normal route of any invading army to Israel from the north and east."








Dr. Oliver B. Greene, "Armageddon . . . which takes place in the plain of Jezreel, the great valley that runs through the middle of the Holy Land from the Mediterranean Sea to the Jordan River. It is approximately 200 miles long and 10 miles wide."







B. Because of the <u>Deception</u> of Satan.

III. The Chronology of the Battle.


A. The drying up of the _____ Euphrates ____ River.




(continued)"... History frequently refers to the great hindrance the Euphrates has been to military movements; and it has always been a line of separation between the peoples living east of it and those living west of it."


